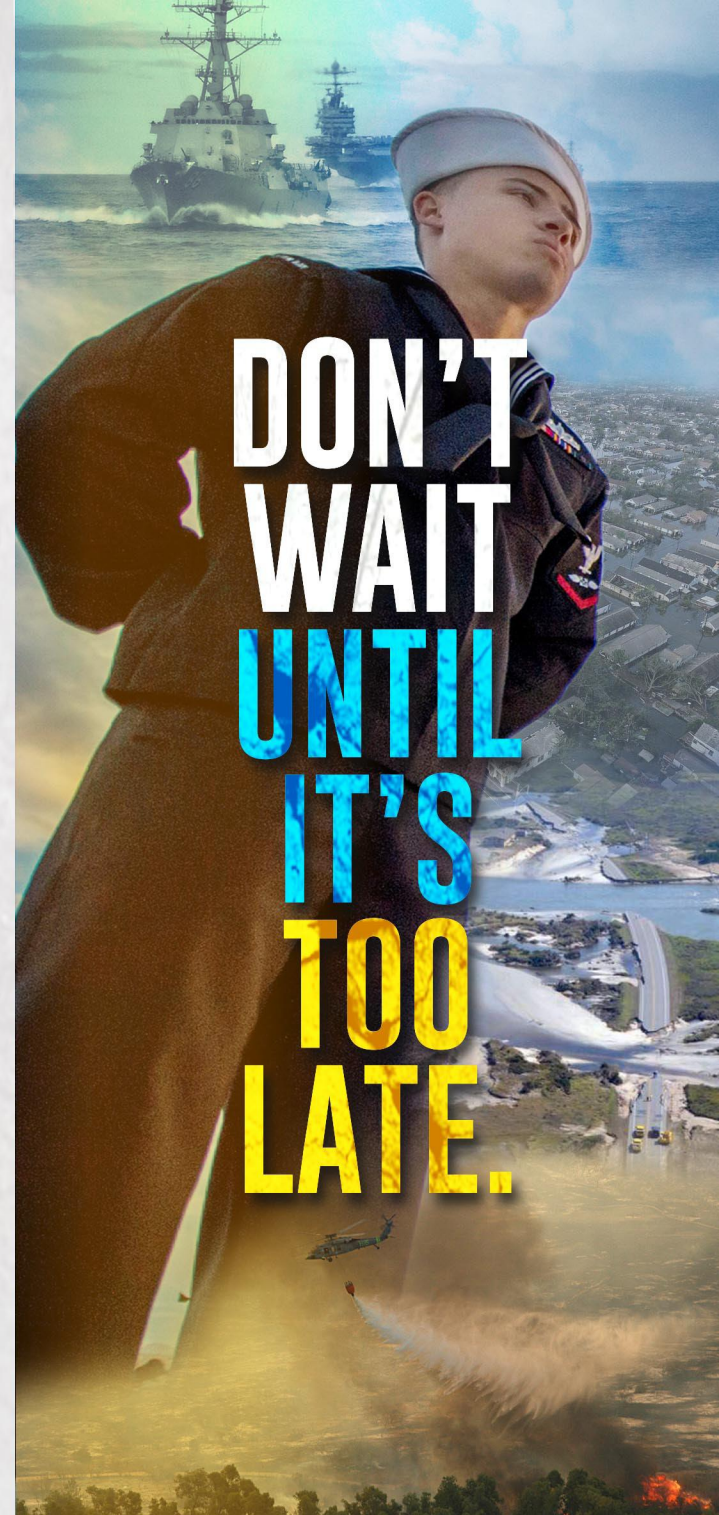

BASIC EMERGENCY KIT

The supplies listed below are recommended for a basic emergency kit. It is also a good idea to build a **Go Kit**, a portable kit that can be stored in your car, at work, and in the event that you must evacuate quickly.

- **Water:** Keep a minimum of one gallon per person per day for at least three days.
- **Food:** Non-perishable food items for three days; include canned goods and low sodium snacks
- **Can opener and eating utensils**
- **First aid kit and prescription medication**
- **Whistle to signal for help**
- **Dust mask and heavy duty gloves**
- **Personal sanitation supplies**, such as moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties
- **Flashlight**
- **Battery powered or hand-cranked, all-hazards NOAA radio**
- **Extra batteries**
- **Cash:** (in local currency) – a minimum of \$100 in small bills
- **Tools to shut off utilities**
- **Local maps**
- **Family Emergency Plan**
- **Command muster information**
- **Important documents** in a portable waterproof container

CAN DISRUPT LIVES

After a major natural or man-made disaster, the Navy must account for the location of all personnel and their families, and assist those in need.

The Navy Family Accountability and Assessment System (NFAAS) is a Web-based tool that the Navy uses to account for, assess, manage, and monitor the recovery process of those affected by a widespread catastrophic event.

NFAAS is accessibly 24/7 from any computer with Internet connectivity. It is also available on smartphones.

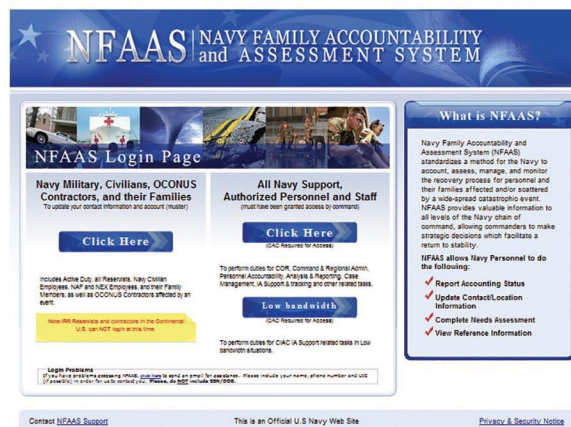
After a declared disaster or emergency event, log in to NFAAS to muster and report your needs. If you cannot access an Internet-ready computer and/or your mobile device is not working, call the Navy Personnel Command Emergency Coordination Center at 1-877-414-5358.

REPORT YOUR STATUS AND NEEDS

Following a declared disaster, log in to NFAAS to muster and report your status. If you have evacuated, identify your new location and provide updated contact information.

If you have been adversely affected, complete a Needs Assessment. An FFSC representative will review your paperwork and contact you to determine the appropriate response and or/assistance required for recovery.

USE REFERENCES FOR YOUR PLANNING AND RECOVERY ANYTIME

Use the reference tab to access information and tools, such as local and military support phone numbers, emergency-related fact sheets, resources guides, and Web links. This information can help you prepare for emergencies and can aid in your recovery if you are affected by a disaster.
