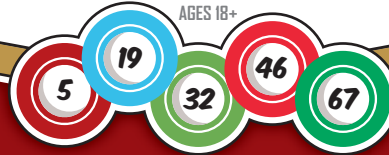

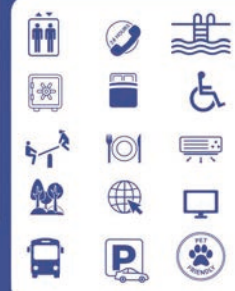

Mojo Crater, Alcantara River & Tornatore Winery

Depart: NAS II 7:30 am, Marinai 7:45 am, NAS I 8:00 am

Ancient and modern, outdoor and inside; this tour offers the best of both worlds! Start the day with a hike from Mojo Crater to the ruins of Byzantine Churches (600 A.D.) and the Alcantara River. Choose to walk along the river, or better yet, dip your toes in! After the hike, enjoy lunch and a wine tasting at the Tornatore Winery.

Along the way, keep your eyes open for clues to how the inhabitants lived, and stop at a rustic farmhouse where a light lunch of local cheeses, wine and other specialties await. End the tour with a stop by the sea where the river ends along the beach of Santa Maria del Focallo. Please bring water, snacks, and wear comfortable shoes.

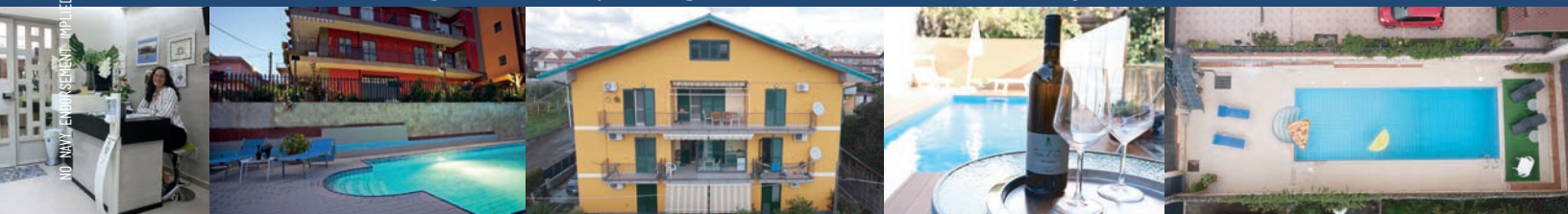
