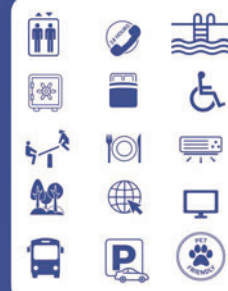

Originally founded as a Greek colony in the 6th century B.C., Agrigento became one of the leading cities in the Mediterranean world. The town of Agrigento is known for its spectacular Valley of Temples and the sacred area of ancient Akragas, which is one of the most important colonies of the Greek Empire. Tour Agrigento's Valley of the Temples, followed by lunch at a local restaurant. Please choose between the meat or fish option upon registration.

We will stop for an Italian panini in town before being transported by bus to the town of Bronte for a pistachio arancini. Please be sure to wear comfortable shoes for this trip.

History buffs, this trip is for you! Spend the day reliving Operation Husky, the military operation that liberated Sicily from Germany when the Allies landed here. We'll stop at Ponte Primosole, the famous battle of the Green and Red Berets; the Landing Museum; an air-raid shelter in the center of Catania; the German cemetery; and Commolwat. Afterward, we'll head to a local restaurant in Catania. **Registration deadline for this trip is Wednesday, January 21.**

The tour will begin at Donna Fugata Castle, an imposing structure with origins dating back to the mid-16th Century. After the tour, pause for a lunch break at the Agriturismo located just in front of the castle. Then, patrons will tour the city of Ragusa which plays host to a wide array of Baroque architecture, including several stunning palaces and churches in the lower Ibla section, including the Cathedral of San Giorgio.

After the walking tour, have lunch at the restaurant located under the castle. Please wear comfortable walking shoes. **Registration deadline for this trip is Wednesday, January 28.**

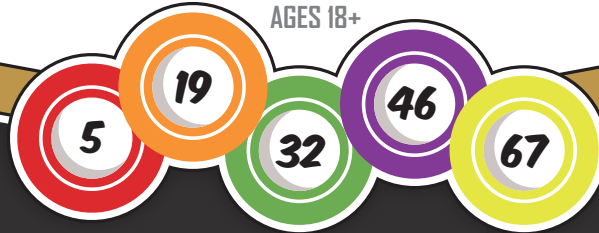
Take a walk through history! Explore the town of "Castiglione", originated from Castel Leone, which dominates the Alcantara Valley. 730 years before Christ, the Greeks built a fortified lookout point to control what represented the only access route to the interior of Sicily. The town was dominated several times by Arabs, Normans and Swabians, and soon became a royal city. Roger of Lauria chose Castiglione as his usual summer residence, and Frederick II Duke of Swabia granted the city the nickname "Animosa" and confirmed the privilege of minting money. The city prospered, and the castle was enriched with new fortifications, and newly built churches and palaces. Afterwards, visit Tornatore Winery for lunch and wine tasting.

Hike: Catafulco Waterfalls

Depart: NAS II 6:30 am, Marinai 6:45 am, NAS I 7:00 am
Return: 7:00 pm **Ages:** 13+ **Cost:** \$90/\$80 Liberty (Includes transportation, guide and lunch)

Nebrodi Park is a beautiful natural area, off the beaten path near the northern coast of the island. Hike through woodlands and explore the waterfall of Catafulco. There, the water at the base creates a natural pool called Marmitta dei Giganti, or Giant's Marble. The hike is 4.5 km and will take an estimated 2-3 hours. Wear long pants, good hiking boots and make sure you keep an eye out for the famous Sicilian black pigs! Afterwards, enjoy lunch at La Falda restaurant for a traditional Sicilian lunch. **Registration deadline for this trip is Wednesday, December 31.**

Hike: Old Noto

Discover the ancient castles, monastery, and caves that played a part in the town's daily life.
