PRIVACY ACT STATEMENT:

AUTHORITY: P.L. 101-89, Sec. 1507, "Military Child Care Act of 1989"; Title 5 U.S.C. 301 Department Regulations; E.O. 9397; and OPNAVINST 1700.9 "Child and Youth Programs."
